### Read Luke 19: 28 – 40

1. Make a list of different characters involved in this story.
2. Consider how each character might have thought about Jesus. Who did they think he was? What did they expect him to do?
3. In Luke 9:20, Jesus asks his disciples: *But what about you? Who do you say I am?* Above are some words that Christians might use to answer this question. Either by referring to these words, or coming up with your own, explore your answer to the question: Who do you say that I am?
4. Now consider what your chosen words mean for you. What implications should they have for your life?
5. How easy it can be to forget the implications of words we use for Jesus or for God! To what degree have we grown complacent about Jesus' claim on our lives?
6. Encourage one another to explore a response to Jesus that you might make during and after this coming Holy Week.
7. Our lives are surrounded by very serious challenges these days. What difference does Jesus make to our hurting world today?
