

### **Bible chat for 1-5-22**

1. How would you describe your own faith? Share stories about how you reached the faith you now have. Was it a long journey or a sudden change?
2. Comment on Saul's conversion story (Acts 9: 1 - 19.) How quickly did it happen? What was he leaving behind? What was he discovering in its place? (You could also look at Philippians 3: 1 - 14).
3. Comment on Peter's reconversion story (John 21:1 - 19). How quickly did this happen? What was Peter leaving behind? What was he discovering in its place? (You could also reflect on Peter's later epistle, looking at 2 Peter 1: 5 - 11.)
4. Can you learn anything relevant for your own conversion to Christ through the stories of Saul/Paul and Simon Peter?
5. The sermon suggested that love was at the core of both stories. Is this love for Jesus or for the church or for the world at large? How can we learn to love each other by getting into each other's skin, as Atticus Finch put it in *To Kill a Mockingbird* by Harper Lee?
6. The sermon was called *Turn, Turn, Turn!* Share tips for how we can get into the habit of frequently turning to Christ and turning to love, and not holding so tightly to our own agenda.
