3. What are the roots of your tree - what gives you sustenance and stability? What refreshes your spirit?
4. What is the trunk and bole of your tree?
5. People often find Paul's words hard to understand. Pick out one key thought that strikes you or interests you or puzzles you from this reading.
6. The roots of our tree: Perhaps ironically, Paul is saying that faith is a simple thing. We must believe in our hearts God raised Jesus from the dead. Why is this so important? What attitudes would it inspire in our lives?
7. The visible part of our tree: Paul also wrote that we must declare with our mouths that Jesus is Lord. Why would this be so important?
