- Do you take the descriptions of verses 24 - 27 literally? If not, what might they convey to us?
- How would believers know when the end was getting near?
- Who would know the schedule for history's end?
- How, then, should we live?
- What does it mean to keep watch, stay awake or stay alert?

- How do you feel about this as a statement of who we are called to be, as a fellowship?
