Read 1 Corinthians 8: 1 - 13.

2. Try to put verse 2 into your own words.
3. Where does knowledge and truth begin, according to verse 3?
4. Consider verses 3 - 6. There was clearly a controversy at Corinth: Was it okay to eat meat that had been offered to idols? Some thought it had been tainted by being involved in worship of some other god. Others thought the meat was unchanged, so why not eat it? Can you think of a similar issue today?
5. Review verses 7 - 13. Can you summarise Paul's argument?
6. To what extent do you think we are in a 'post-truth' society?
7. How can we promote the living of True Lives in today's complex world?
