1. **Read Romans 1: 18 - 23.** What does this idea of Exchange explored here (also in verse 25 and 26) add to our understanding of sin?
2. **Read Romans 3: 9 - 20.** How would Jewish Christians have responded to the idea that they, just as much as Jews, were under the power of sin?
3. Do we as Christians find ourselves thinking we are morally better than most people in the world?
4. **Read Mark 7: 14 - 23.** In your own words, what is the point Jesus is making in these verses?
5. Can you accept that out of your own heart evil thoughts come, and that this leads to evil deeds?
6. Do you think a church is a bastion of righteousness or a place for honestly seeking truth and growth?
7. How do people around us see our church - a place for self-righteous holy Joes or a place for honest engagement with life? How can we improve their understanding?
