5. Consider 6:14. Kindness to a friend reflects God's lovingkindness. What makes Eliphaz and his pals unable to give that lovingkindness? Why are they like a failing stream in the desert?
6. Are there any models or ways of looking at life that you may need to abandon or refine?
7. How do you typically respond to a friend in need?
