2. Read verses 7 - 9. In what sense had Job's friends spoken **untruthfully**, given that they were sharing accepted doctrine?
3. Would you have given Job's friends a new chance to become a bit kinder?
4. Job's friends make a sacrifice and are prayed for; what process or rituals might help those who have failed in our day to move beyond their failure?
5. Read verses 10 - 11. Talk about some of the blessings you enjoy in your life. Does any part of you consider that you **deserve** them, or are they simply expressions of God's overflowing grace and love?
6. Read verse 13. Can a new person in one's life really compensate for someone we loved who has died? How can we open the heart to love again?
7. Read verses 14 - 15. Share what is remarkable about these verses. What new graces might God be giving to the church presently?
8. Read verses 16 - 17. How can we comfort a person who is feeling low, if they really feel that things may never get better? What can we do to bring them through to a period of hope?
9. How can we ourselves trust, in a period of challenge, that spring is coming?
