### A) Read Psalm 19: 1 - 6

- What does this section tell us about the heavens and the skies?
- Share your own impressions of the sun, the night sky or the stars. What impact does this aspect of the natural world have on you?
- Now that we have much more accurate models of cosmology, how should we read these verses?

### B) Read Psalm 19: 7 - 11

- What does this section tell us about the law of the Lord?
- How do these descriptions compare with your own experience of this Law, or Word of God?
- How does part A relate to part B? What do we learn about the Law of God by juxtaposing these two parts of the Psalm? In what ways does the Law reflect the nature of the Sun? In what ways is it different?

### C) Read Psalm 19: 12 - 14

- Answer the question in verse 12. How can we pray or meditate to deal with our own hidden faults?
- How should we deal with 'willful sins' in our life? Why do we sin, if we know the sin is not good for us?
- Reflect on verse 14. How can we grow to live our lives in the centre of God's heart? Can a human heart reflect the glories of this whole Psalm?
- Ephesians tells us to 'Find out what pleases the Lord'. How might we do that?
