5. Job's comforters unhelpfully blamed Job himself for his predicament. To what extent is talking about blame useful during the current pandemic?
6. Give examples how Jesus ministered to the socially-excluded. Which ones inspire you the most?
7. The first disciples were locked away for fear of the Jews after Jesus' crucifixion. What good things happened during this time, and how does that help us today?
8. In Acts 16:16 - 34 we read of Paul and Silas locked away in prison. What do we learn from Paul's attitude and behaviour during his lockdown?
